



## **MAJOR CONSTRUCTORS SUPPORT ROYAL COMMISSION**

Australia's major construction companies have called on the Abbott Government to ensure that the Trade Union Royal Commission completes its terms of reference.

Australian Constructors Association (ACA) Executive Director, Lindsay Le Compte, said today that the ACA regarded the Royal Commission's work as critical to the long term integrity and viability of the construction industry and must continue.

"There is no room for lawlessness or inappropriate practices, and the ACA continues to maintain its total support of the Royal Commission", Mr Le Compte said.

Mr Le Compte also said that the work of the Royal Commission was integral to the need to have an effective regulatory structure for the construction industry and the ACA also re-confirmed its support of the ABCC and related legislation that recently failed to pass the Senate.

"The ACA urges the government to continue to pursue legislative and regulatory proposals that will improve the operation and standing of the industry and support it as a great place to work", Mr Le Compte said.
